

Wave Reader

Viewing a site live: Double click on Wave Reader icon on desktop. Click connect; enter your user name and password. Click OK. An address book will open. Click on the site you want to view and click connect. Cameras will appear for that site. You can click on individual cameras or multiple cameras to view live.

View prerecorded images: After doing the above, click the view playback icon. A disk analysis screen will appear. Move the cursor over the disk analysis screen for the cameras you are interested in viewing. The date and time will change as you go from left to right. Click and drag from left to right on the screen to select the date and time you want to view, then release. A menu will appear, you can play images, search, and zoom in or out. Zoom in brings the date and time closer to a specific time and date you are looking for. Zoom out gives you a wider variety of dates and times.

Save video clips to a file: Go to the view playback icon. Click on the icon. A disk analysis screen will appear. Click on the disk analysis screen and drag the cursor from left to right. When you release the mouse a pop up window will appear asking if you want to play, save to file, search, zoom in, or cancel. Click zoom in, It will be easier now to get exact date and time. Click play video and the video will play from the start of the event to the end of the event. If the event you want to save is in the video clip you played go to the disk analysis screen and click save file. Name the file and click save.

Viewing saved files: Go to video images folder and click the wave reader file you want to view. The wave reader screen will appear. Go to File, Open. Video image will appear and play. Use play, rewind, fast forward, etc. Buttons to play the video clip.

To burn CD: Burn the video to disk like you would with any other file.
